### FLOODING SOURCE(S) & REVISED REACH(ES)

Chino Valley Stream - from immediately upstream of Hill View Drive to approximately 3,900 feet upstream of Center Street

Chino Valley Stream East - from the confluence with Chino Valley Stream to approximately 16,600 feet upstream of Center Street

Chino Valley Stream (Tributary) - from the confluence with Chino Valley Stream to approximately 1,800 feet upstream of Belinda Trail

### SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This Letter of Map Revision (LOMR) reissues a LOMR dated November 15, 2010 (Case No. 10-09-2672P), which revised the flood hazard data for the above-referenced flooding sources. A new FIRM and FIS report for Yavapai County, Arizona and Incorporated Areas became effective on September 3, 2010. Because the flood hazard modifications associated with the November 15 LOMR were shown on the previous effective FIRM and FIS report dated June 6, 2001, the November 15 LOMR is not valid. This LOMR shows those flood hazard modifications on the new effective FIRM and FIS report.

### DETERMINATION

This document provides the determination from the Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) regarding a request for a Letter of Map Revision (LOMR) for the area described above. Using the information submitted, we have determined that a revision to the flood hazards depicted in the Flood Insurance Study (FIS) report and/or National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) map is warranted. This document revises the effective NFIP map, as indicated in the attached documentation. Please use the enclosed annotated map panels revised by this LOMR for floodplain management purposes and for all flood insurance policies and renewals in your community.

This determination is based on the flood data presently available. The enclosed documents provide additional information regarding this determination.
