  - Without Base Flood Elevation (BFE) Zone A, V, A99
  - With BFE or Depth Zone AE, AO, AH, VE, AR Regulatory Floodway
  - 0.2% Annual Chance Flood Hazard, Areas of 1% Annual Chance Flood with average depth less than one foot or with drainage areas of less than one square mile Zone X
  - Future Conditions 1% Annual Chance Flood Hazard Zone X
  - Area with Reduced Flood Risk due to Levee See Notes Zone X

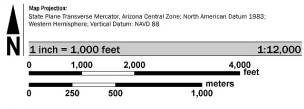

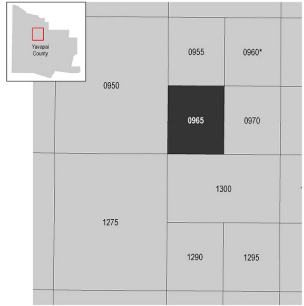
To obtain more detailed information in areas where Base Flood Elevations (BFEs) and/or Floodways have been determined, users are encouraged to consult the Flood Profiles and Floodway Data and/or Survey of Channel Elevations tables contained within the Flood Insurance Study (FIS) report that accompanies this FIRM. Users should be aware that BFEs shown on the FIS report are not absolute elevations. These elevations are relative to the datum used in the FIS report and should be used as the base datum for flood elevation information accordingly. Flood elevation data generated in the FIS report should be utilized in conjunction with the FIS report for purposes of construction and/or floodplain management.

Base map information shown on this FIRM was derived from digital data provided by Yavapai County. Digital orthorectification was collected by the U.S. Department of Agriculture Farm Service Agency (2015) and by Digital Globe imagery (2014).
