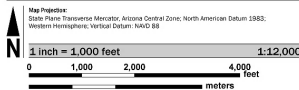

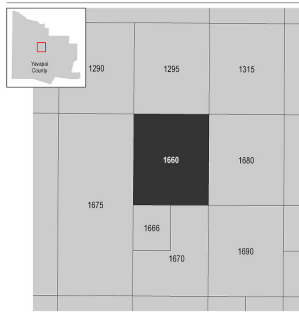
To obtain more detailed information in areas where Base Flood Elevations (BFEs) and/or Floodway Designations have been determined, users are encouraged to consult the Flood Profiles and Floodway Data and/or Summary of Channel Elevations tables contained within the Flood Insurance Study (FIS) report that accompanies this FIRM. Users should be aware that BFEs shown on the FIRM represent rounded whole-foot elevations. These elevations are for informational purposes only and should not be used as the sole source of flood elevation information. Accordingly, flood elevation data presented in the FIS report should be utilized in conjunction with the FIRM for purposes of construction and/or floodplain management.
