- SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD AREAS**
 - Without Base Flood Elevation (BFE) (Zone A, AE)
 - With BFE or Depth (Zone AE, AD, AH, VE, AR)
 - Regulatory Floodway

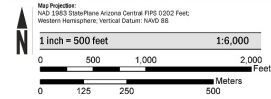

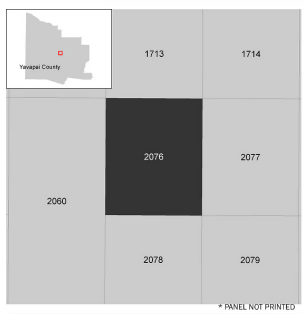
