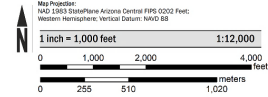

Communities occupying land on adjacent FIRM panels must obtain a current copy of the adjacent panel as well as the current FIRM data. These maps are obtained directly from the Map Service Center at the number listed above. For community and countywide map notes refer to the Flood Insurance Study report for the jurisdiction.
