

NOTES TO USERS

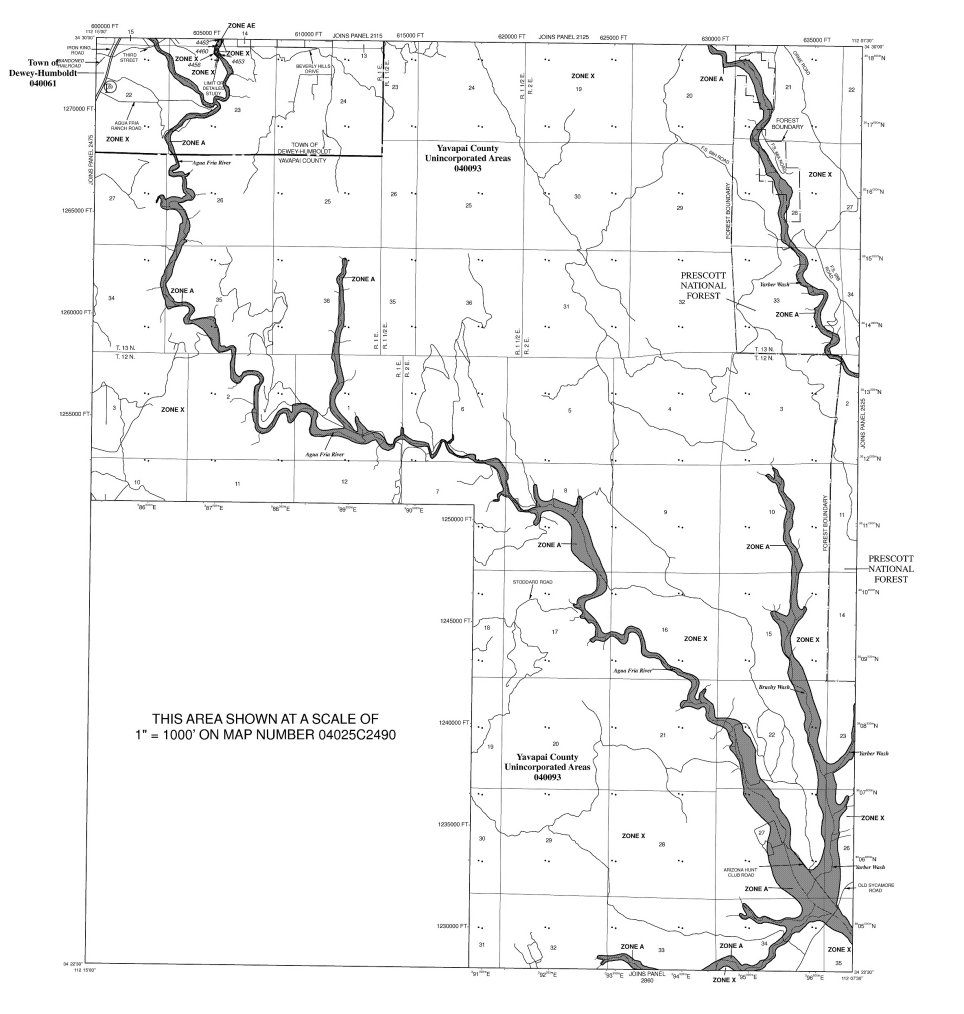
